

GENERAL

- 1) Students must apply, enrol and remain on a full-time undergraduate programme of study, which is not FdA Childhood Studies, and which would normally count towards Student Number Control.
- 2) Students must fall under the new fee regime which came into place in September 2012.
- 3) The award is only open to students who choose to make the University of Winchester their firm choice institution by the UCAS deadline (usually end of May).
- 4) Students must be UK, EU or Channel Island domiciled.
- 5) Students must have achieved one of the set of qualification combinations to be eligible for the award.
- 6) This award applies to students starting in September 2018. Students deferring entry until September 2019 will need to consult the Highflier Academic Achievement Award on offer for that year of entry.
- 7) Recipients must maintain an academic level throughout their studies to continue receiving their Highflier Academic Achievement Award in subsequent years of study (if applicable). This will be an average mark of at least 70% at the end of each year of study, as agreed by the relevant examination board.
- 8) Recipients will be enrolled onto the University of Winchester Scholars Scheme. In addition to maintaining the academic level as described above, recipients will also be required to abide by the Scheme's attendance and activity requirements each academic year to continue receiving their Highflier Academic Achievement Award in subsequent years of study (if applicable).
- 9) You must remain enrolled as a full-time student for the duration of the course. Variation from the course (changing to part-time study etc.) may affect your eligibility for the Highflier Academic Achievement Award.
- 10) Recipients will be required to help promote the University through press releases and University publicity materials.

APPLICATIONS

- 11) No specific direct application needs to be made for the Highflier Academic Achievement Award. The University will make their assessment using the data supplied on your application and your confirmed entry qualifications.
- 12) The University may ask for proof of qualifications if required.

PAYMENTS

- 13) The award value for 2018/19 entrants is £200.00 per academic year, subject to the conditions as stated above. Students will be offered the choice to receive the award as a bursary or a fee waiver. If you opt for a bursary, the award will be paid in a single instalment in February of the academic year. If you opt for a fee waiver, it will be applied in May of the academic year.
- 14) Any debt owed to the University of Winchester will be offset against the award.
- 15) Withdrawal and/or interruption of study may affect your entitlement to the Highflier Academic Achievement Award and may result in you having to return any monies received.
